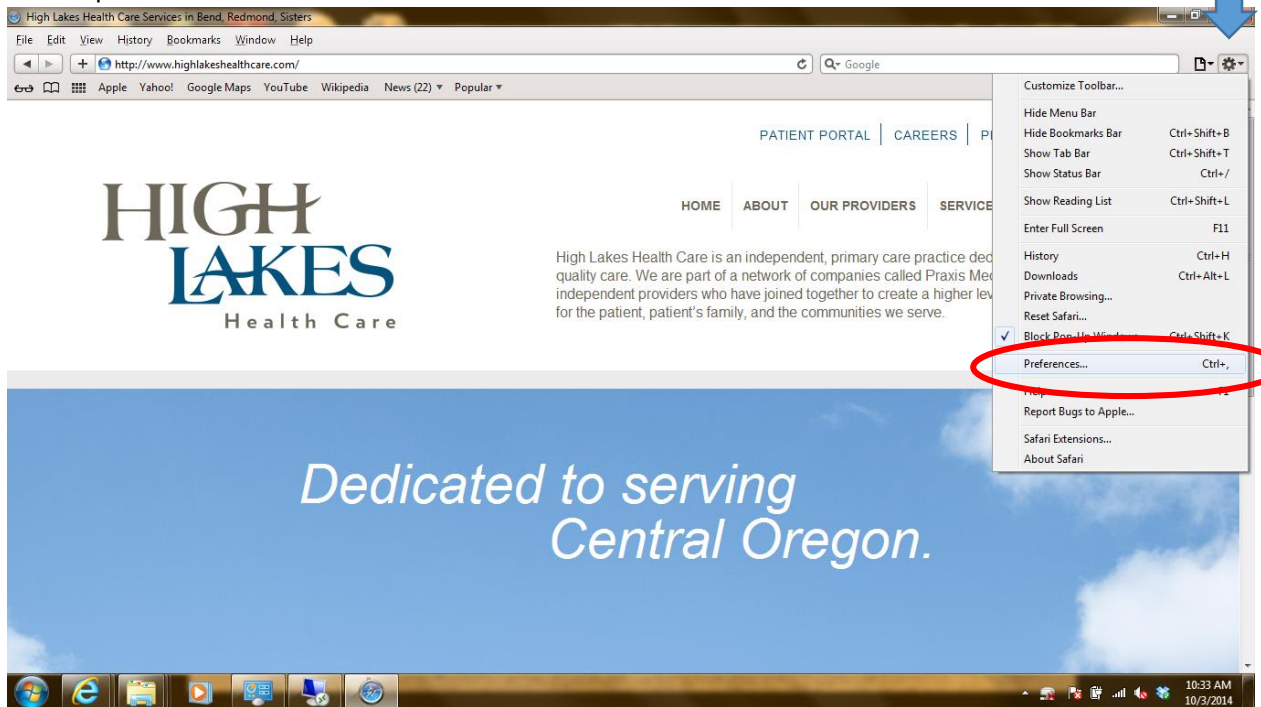


Adjusting Safari to use with our Patient Portal

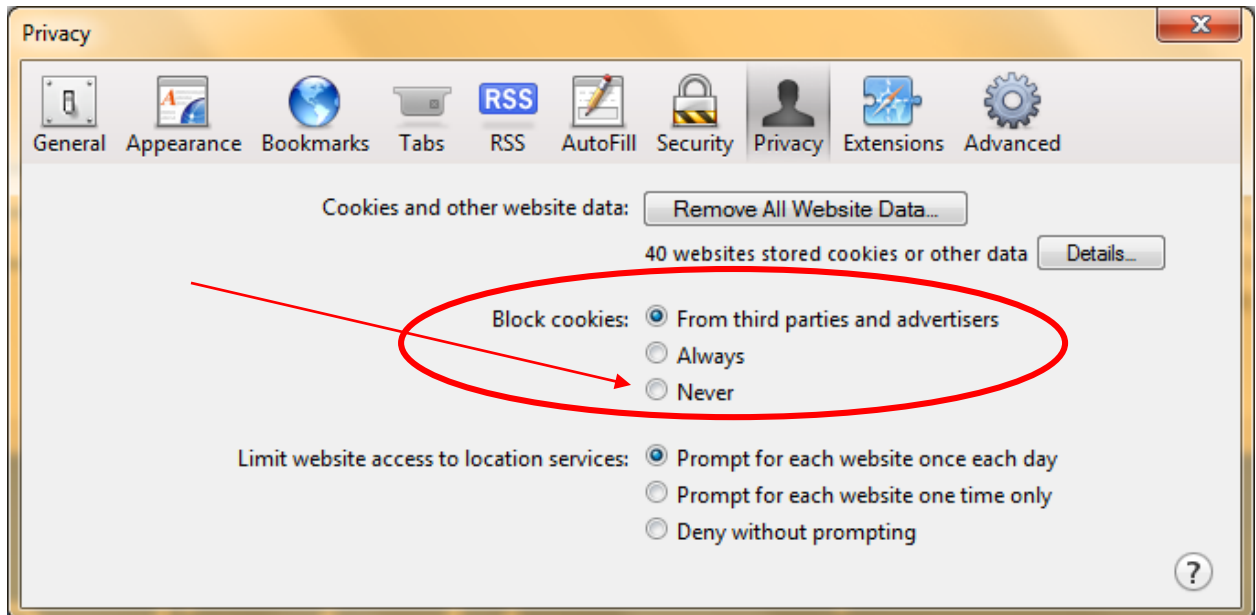
Our patient portal needs to have a cookie placed on your device to allow access to our services. By default, Safari will block cookies from most sites that are not 'Apple Approved'. This can be disabled temporarily to allow our website to download the correct cookie.

The screenshots are from a PC version on Safari. However, these screen should be similar to what you are seeing on your Mac.

1. Access the **Preferences** for Safari. In this screen, click on the **Tools** icon on the right side from the dropdown menu



2. In the window that opens, select the tab labeled **Privacy**. You will see a selection that says '*Block cookies:*' Select **Never**.



3. Close this window by clicking on the red X.
4. You should now be able to log into our Patient Portal. Once you have logged into our Portal and updated your password, **you can reverse these steps and set Safari to block cookies from third parties and advertisers.**
 - a. Go to Safari Preferences
 - b. Go to the Privacy tab
 - c. Select '*From third parties and advertisers*'
 - d. Close the Preferences window.
